

# TEXAS RADIO SHORTWAVE

## RECEPTION REPORT GUIDE

1. We verify correct reception reports emailed to [texasradioshortwave@protonmail.com](mailto:texasradioshortwave@protonmail.com).
2. We like reports written in English.
3. Reports should cover at least 20 minutes of listening. We make exceptions if distance or other conditions make reception difficult.
4. Computer programs like Shazam can often name songs. Otherwise, please include lyrics so we can check.
5. Include the time songs played, the time and approximate text of announcements, a SINPO or SIO signal quality report, and details about your receiver and antenna.
6. We like to receive audio clips so we can hear our signal.
7. If you use a remote receiver (SDR), let us know and tell us its location.
8. Comments help us plan future programs, so tell us what you did and didn't like about what you heard.

We sometimes partner with broadcasters, other program producers, and radio clubs to air Texas Radio Shortwave shows. These partners may offer a separate QSL for the program. Although they may have different QSL standards, we suggest you use our guidelines to help ensure you'll receive a QSL regardless of whom you send your report to.
